3. The Crowning with Thorns - Soldiers mock Jesus by placing a crown of thorns on His head.
4. The Carrying of the Cross - Jesus carries His cross to Calvary.
5. The Crucifixion and Death of Jesus - Jesus is nailed to the cross and dies for our sins.

5. The Institution of the Eucharist - At the Last Supper, Jesus gives us His Body and Blood in the Eucharist.
